
## HERITAGE WEEK...


## **Abbotsbury and South Dorset Ridgeway Walk**



**It started with a kiss.....the life and times of Dylan Thomas**

**Talk by Brian and Jaqueline Sutton**

It really, really, did start with a kiss! Come along and find out! Dylan Thomas was both a famous and infamous Welshman. As a poet/writer he published 90 poems and will always be remembered for his ground-breaking work 'Under Milk Wood'. However, his life became one long drink at the bar encouraged by his exhibitionist wife, Caitlin, and his friend and fellow drinking companion, Augustus John. Dylan died aged 39 in 1953 leaving behind him a dysfunctional family, a pile of debts and lyrical writing that has become part of our heritage.




## Saturday 27th November 2021 is the day we decorate Allendale House for Christmas.....




